FACILITY	This indoor pool consists of 11 eight foot wide 50 m lanes. Eight lanes will be used for competition and two short course lanes will be designated as warm-up / warm down. The lanes are marked by continuous non-turbulent lane lines. Paragon starting blocks are used at the deep end. A fully automatic Colorado Timing system will be used with pads during the meet.
FACILITY NOTES	<p>NO Parking on the grass. The Facility has a brand new parking lot. This is a public facility and will be open to the public during the meet. Please protect your valuables and lock your cars.</p> <p>DO NOT PARK in the handicap spaces if you do not have a handicap tag. Also, DO NOT PARK in the paved area leading to the large roll-up door on the side of the Facility. This area must be kept clear for emergency vehicles.</p> <p>Please convey the following information to your swimmers and parents:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Radios, noisemakers or anything else that might cause inconvenience to swimmers, coaches, officials, workers or spectators are prohibited in the pool area.2. Walkie-talkies are prohibited inside the recreation center as their use interferes with the headsets used by our officials.3. Flash photography is prohibited during the start of heats.

RULES	The meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Code and the Kentucky Swimming Championship Meet Rules, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are herein stated. FINA starting procedures will be used.
QUALIFYING PERIOD	The qualifying period is defined, as the 1 st day of the July 2004 Kentucky Swimming Long Course A Championship, July 29, 2004, through the entry deadline, July 18, 2005.

ELIGIBILITY
AND TIME
STANDARDS

With the exception of the 800 m freestyle events, participation in an individual event is restricted to those swimmers who have not achieved any of the Qualifying Times for the July 2005 Kentucky Swimming Long Course A Championship, where **the Senior Qualifying Times will apply to the 15 & Over events in this meet**, during the qualifying period of July 29, 2004 through the meet entry deadline, July 18, 2005.

For the 800 m freestyle events, participation is restricted to those swimmers who have not achieved any of the 800 m or 1500 m Qualifying Times for the July 2005 Kentucky Swimming Long Course A Championship, where **the Senior Qualifying Times will apply to the 15 & Over events in this meet**, during the qualifying period of July 29, 2004 through the meet entry deadline, July 18, 2005.

A swimmer may not participate in any relay in which the swimmer has achieved any of the Qualifying Times for the July 2005 Kentucky Swimming Long Course A Championship in that stroke and distance, where **the Senior Qualifying Times will apply to the 15 & Over events in this meet**, during the qualifying period of July 29, 2004 through the meet entry deadline, July 18, 2005.

POSTINGS	<p>Entries will be posted on the Kentucky Swimming website in two forms:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A psych sheet sorted by event number with entries for each event sorted in rank order, and 2. An entry list sorted first by team and then by athlete showing entries for each athlete.
ENTRY LIMITS	Swimmers may enter a maximum of four individual events and one relay on each day.
ENTRY FEES	<p>\$4.00 for each individual event \$8.00 for each relay event</p> <p>There will be no refund of entry fees.</p>
ENTRY SURCHARGES	<p>\$1.50 per swimmer Kentucky Swimming Surcharge and \$2.00 per swimmer Facilities Surcharge</p>
ENTRIES	<p>Entries must be submitted electronically (Hy-Tek or SDIF). Handwritten, telephone or fax entries will not be accepted. If the USSID for any swimmer is omitted that swimmer's entries will not be accepted. All swimmers' registration will be checked against Kentucky Swimming's database of registered athletes.</p> <p>Note: If your team does not use Hy-Tek's Team Manager or equivalent, then WinTM II Lite, downloadable free of charge from Hy-Tek's web site, should be used to prepare your entries.</p>
ENTRY DEADLINE	Electronic entries must be in the entry chair's possession no later than Monday, July 18, 2005.
LATE ENTRIES	No late entries will be accepted unless due to administrative error and shall be at the sole discretion of the meet referee.
PAYMENT and WAIVER	Payment and signed waiver must be sent to the Entry Chair postmarked no later than Tuesday, July 19, 2005.
SEED TIMES	<p>The entered time should be the swimmer's best long course time during the qualifying period. NTs are allowed but are discouraged. A stopwatch time during an unofficial time trial is better than an NT.</p> <p>Seeding will be done in the following order: Conforming Times, Non-Conforming Times, NTs. A "Conforming Time" is defined as one from a 50-meter pool. A "Non-Conforming Time" is one from a pool other than 50 meters.</p> <p>Any entry made with a time that meets or is faster than any of the Qualifying Times for the July 2005 Kentucky Swimming Long Course A Championship will be discarded.</p>
SEED TIMES 8 & UNDER EXCEPTION	NTs are NOT allowed. A stopwatch time during an unofficial time trial IS acceptable. All NT entries will be discarded.
SEEDING	<p>All Friday events will be deck seeded. Positive sign-in is required.</p> <p>All other individual events 400 m and longer will be deck seeded. Positive sign-in is required.</p> <p>All relay events will be deck seeded.</p> <p>Events 123-124 (800m freestyle) will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating heats, women then men.</p>
POSITIVE SIGN-IN EVENTS	<p>Positive sign-in for events 1-18 closes 30 minutes prior to the start of Friday competition.</p> <p>Positive sign-in for events 45-48 closes 30 minutes prior to the start of Saturday competition.</p> <p>Positive sign-in for events 123-124 closes at the start of Sunday competition.</p>
RELAY CARDS	Relay cards will be distributed in each team's meet packet. Each relay team is responsible for delivering their completed relay card to the lane timer when reporting for the event. At this time, the relay cards must clearly indicate, in the appropriate order, the four swimmers who will compete. Failure to provide the completed relay card may result in that team's disqualification.
CLERK OF COURSE	There will be no clerk of course.
SCORING	<p>Individual events – 8 places – 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11</p> <p>Relay events – 8 places – 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22</p>

 Championship Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place (individual and relay events)
 Championship Ribbons for 4th through 8th place (individual and relay events)
 Championship Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams.

LONG COURSE B CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS
 Championship Ribbons for 1st through 8th place (individual and relay events)
 Championship Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in large team division.
 Championship Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in small team division.

LONG COURSE B CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISIONS
 The large team division shall be the 1st ten teams when ranked according to number of swimmers entered. The small team division shall be the remaining teams (11th and up).

ADMISSION & HEAT SHEETS
 \$2.00 per day for adults; Children 12 years old and younger - Free. Heat Sheets will be sold for \$2.00 per session.

HOSPITALITY
 A Hospitality Room will be offered for coaches and officials.

COACHES' MEETINGS
 Coaches' Meeting will be held 15 minute prior to the start of each session.

OFFICIALS' MEETING
 Officials' Meeting will be held 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.

TIMERS
 Competing teams must supply lane timers. The Meet Director will determine timer assignments.

RELIEF TIMERS
 It is the responsibility of the team who is assigned the timing detail to provide any necessary relief for their timer(s).
